ZERO ROBOTICS IS A FREE ROBOTICS PROGRAMMING COMPETITION WHERE THE ROBOTS ARE SPHERES SATELLITES INSIDE THE INTERNATIONAL SPACE STATION (ISS). ZERO ROBOTICS IS DESIGNED TO CULTIVATE INTEREST IN SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING AND MATHEMATICS, AND TO ALLOW MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS UNPRECEDENTED ACCESS TO THE INTERNATIONAL SPACE STATION.

THE COMPETITION STARTS ONLINE WHERE TEAMS COMPETE TO SOLVE AN ANNUAL CHALLENGE. PARTICIPANTS CAN CREATE, EDIT, SAVE, SIMULATE, AND SUBMIT CODE, ALL FROM A WEB BROWSER. AFTER SEVERAL PHASES OF VIRTUAL COMPETITION, FINALISTS ARE SELECTED TO COMPETE ABOARD THE **ISS** in a live championship!
